Normanby and Owby Neighbourhood Plan Sunday 4th November

We would like to bring to your attention a community meeting that is taking place in the school hall on Sunday 4th November 2pm to 5pm. It is hoped that as many villagers attend and complete all the surveys. This event is particularly aimed at the children and any child who is resident in either Owby or Normanby will be asked to complete a survey about the Community Park and the neighbourhood Plan. Every child who completes the survey will get a lucky dip prize of small toys or stationary. There will be information about what is happening at the Community Park so far and what is being done to make the area safe. The committee are looking for ideas as to what play equipment the children would like and any fund raising ideas people may have.

The Neighbourhood Plan is a plan that has been put together and looks at everything that is liked in the village and how the village can be maintained for future generations. The children will complete a survey about things they like and draw a picture of their favourite thing in the village.

As well as this there will be a few games, such as guess the weight of the sweets in a jar, the chance to have glitter tattoos and refreshments and cakes. There will be a small cost for these but everything raised will go towards the community park fund.

It is important that the children engage with this project whilst they are growing up here.
